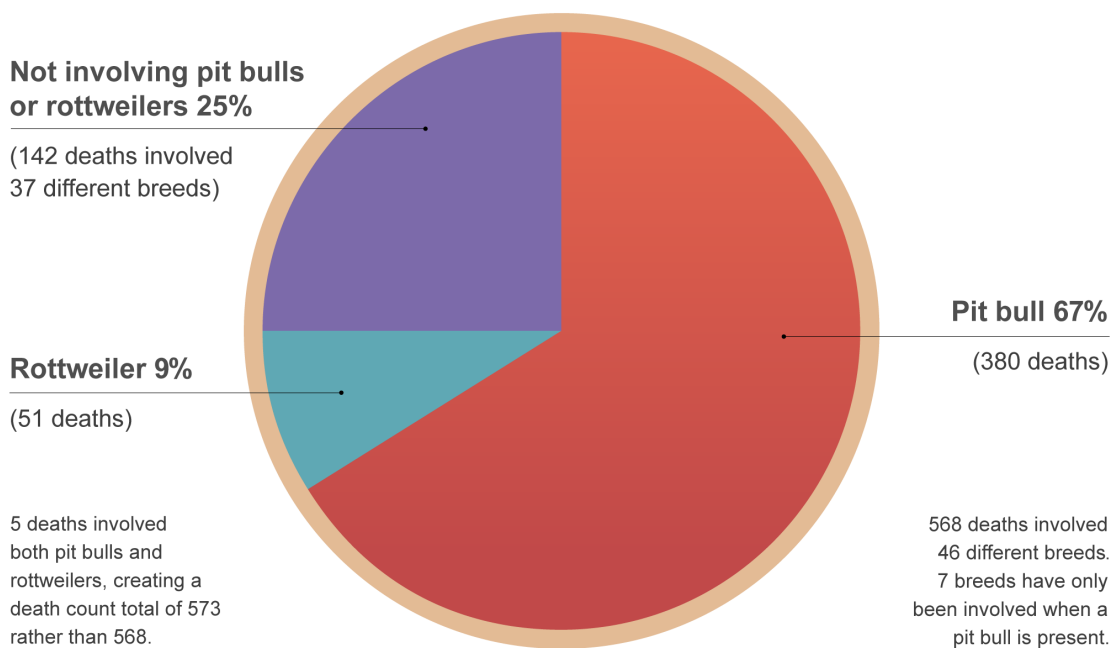


16 Year U.S. Dog Bite Fatality Chart - 2005 to 2020

During this 16-year period, 568 Americans suffered death due to dog bite injury.



Breeds of Dogs Involved in the Most Human Fatalities

Dog Breed	Fatalities	% of Total
Pit bull	380	66.9%
Rottweiler	51	9.0%
Mixed-breed	29	5.1%
German shepherd	24	4.2%
Mastiff/Bullmastiff [†]	20	3.5%
American bulldog	18	3.2%
Husky	14	2.5%
Combination of 39 dog breeds [‡]	≤ 10

[†] This category includes: Italian, English, South African and Neapolitan mastiffs, bullmastiffs and mastiffs. This category excludes: cane corsos, presa canarios and Dogo argentinos.

[‡] 4 dog breeds contributed to 10 to 6 deaths, 12 breeds contributed to 5 to 2 deaths, and 23 breeds contributed to 1 death. 10% of all fatal attacks involved multiple breeds, thus the total number of deaths attributed to each breed will always exceed the actual number of deaths.
